



2017 Summer Camp Program

The Jacksonville Children's Commission (JCC) provides Summer Camp opportunities for low-income and special needs children in Duval County.

Participant Eligibility

To be eligible for camp participation all children must be:

- Residents of Duval County (only)
- Rising Kindergarteners through rising 8th graders

However, all camps do not serve all age ranges—parents should contact the camps individually to inquire.

* *Children must be five years old by Sept. 1, 2017 AND entering kindergarten this fall.*

AND either:

Special Needs/Special Education

- A form from a school with the child's name and current school year date
- A current diagnosis report from a medical or psychological professional verifying the child would require an IEP if enrolled in public schools
- A McKay Scholarship letter or form with child's name and current school year date

OR:

National School Lunch Program

- Report card showing attendance at a school participating in the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP)
- Income based free/reduced lunch-quality letter from child's school
- A current copy of Step Up For Students Scholarship letter
- Verification household family income does not exceed 185% of the Federal Poverty Level
Parents must provide copies of documentation to the camp upon registration

Parents/caregivers interested in enrolling their child in camp this summer should contact the camps directly to learn more about how and when to register their child.

Hours & Days of Operation

Camps will be provided by various youth-serving non-profit organizations in five to six week-long sessions, operating Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. Camps will run between June 12th and August 11th, but **specific dates may vary for each location.**

Parent Fees

Camps may charge parents a nominal fee that should be thoroughly outlined in their enrollment applications.
